**BOMA GREATER CLEVELAND ORGANIZES “CHOPPER DROP” TO RAISE  
MONEY FOR THE CLEVELAND FOOD BANK**

CLEVELAND, Ohio July 11, 2005 – The Building Owners and Managers Association (BOMA) of Greater Cleveland has hired Classic Stainless Helicopter to drop up to 1,000 golf balls over a green at the Country Club of Fox Meadows on July 11, 2005 in an effort to raise money for the Cleveland Food Bank. Members of the association are selling numbered golf balls for \$20 per ball. On the day of the golf outing all the balls that have been purchased will be dropped out of a “chopper” over a practice green. The individual who purchased the ball landing closest to the hole will take home one-half the proceeds. If BOMA sells 1,000 balls, the winner will take home almost \$10,000 and \$10,000 will be donated to the Cleveland Food Bank.
